Priest as Teacher

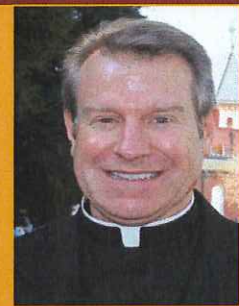
